THE “GIRL IN THE PICTURE,” KIM PHUC, BRINGS MESSAGE OF PEACE AND HEALING TO BOSTON

Who: **Kim Phuc**, the young girl from Vietnam photographed in 1972 running down a road, screaming from Napalm induced third-degree burns. Associated Press Photographer, Nick Ut later won a Pulitzer Prize for this photo.

What: **The Burn Survivors of New England** will host **“Witness History”** a reception and presentation with Kim Phuc, A UNESCO Goodwill Ambassador for Peace, Kim has dedicated her life to healing the wounds of war.
