



Phoenix World Burn Congress

Dates: October 2, 2019 – October 5, 2019

Location: Hilton Anaheim and Anaheim Convention Center

General Schedule:

1. Pre-Conference Workshops on Wed 10/2 afternoon
2. Walk of Remembrance on Wed 10/2 early evening followed by Kick-Off Event
3. Keynote speakers to begin on Thursday, 10/3.
4. General sessions, breakout sessions, support groups will run on various days 10/3 – 10/5
5. Talent Show on Friday 10/4 in the evening
6. Closing celebration on Sat 10/5 in the evening

To help you prepare for WBC, here are some of the anticipated expenses (\$USD):

1. In-Person Registration Fee for 2019:
 - Early Bird Regular Registration - \$305
 - Regular Registration (price increase on Sept 2nd at midnight) - \$415
 - Early Bird CEU Registration - \$415 **on average, we offer ff14 CEUs*
 - Regular CEU Registration (Price increase on Sept 2nd at midnight) - \$520

Pre-Conference Workshops:

- \$40 – Must Pre-Register

Virtual Registration:

- Virtual CEU Registration - \$40
- General Registration - \$0

Registration will be online – anticipate registration opening up in April 2019. Stay tuned to our website and social media.



2. Hotel stay at Hilton Anaheim:

\$196 + tax/fee per night = **Estimated** to come out to **\$230.61 per night**

3. Flight:

Depends on where you are flying to and from – estimate around **\$500-600 round trip**. John Wayne Airport, Orange County (Airport Code: SNA) is the closest airport to the conference center and will be the only airport where transportation will be provided from.

4. Transportation:

Will only be provided to/from John Wayne Airport, Orange County (Airport Code: SNA). Transportation will only be provided on:

- Wednesday, October 2nd from John Wayne Airport to the Hilton Anaheim
- Sunday, October 6 from the Hilton Anaheim to John Wayne Airport

5. Meals:

There will be a few meals provided during the week but please be sure to budget for food and incidentals – around **\$75 per day per person**.

Provided meals (i.e. those included with registration) are yet to be determined.



6. Phoenix UBelong Youth and Teen:

7-17 year olds

Young burn survivors, their siblings and parents, or children of burn survivors

Once registration opens (April 2019) – Each child will need to register individually. Regular registration fees apply and a parent or caregiver must be registered as well. **Space is limited and we anticipate the program filling up so once registration opens, register in advance and early.**
